What is Housing Futures?

Housing Futures is the National Housing Federation's innovation programme, and the biggest collaborative exercise ever undertaken in the housing sector.

Over the next 18 months, housing associations across the UK will be working together to tackle the systemic challenges in housing.

How can I get involved?

Housing Futures covers [five phases of work](#) beginning with the Identify phase to pinpoint key housing challenges.

Let your voice be heard! What are the big challenges facing our organisation, customers/tenants? What do you think the sector should work together to tackle?

Your suggestions should be challenges that cannot be solved by one association alone. They should also be problems that affect a significant number of people and are likely to keep getting worse.

Run an Identify workshop

As collaboration is at the heart of this programme, you could run an Identify workshop in your team meetings to generate discussion around what the Housing Futures challenge area should be for our region. We have further information about how to run a workshop [here](#).
